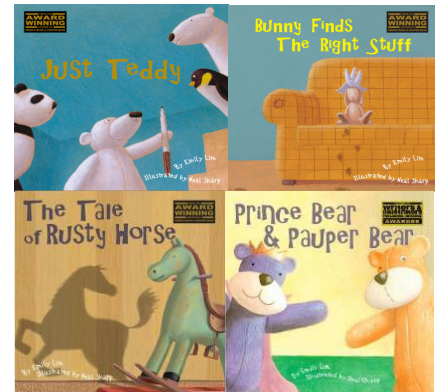

I. BUNNY FINDS THE RIGHT STUFF (New Release: July 2009)

Bunny, a floppy rabbit with flat feet, thinks he is missing out when he notices that the other toys are better stuffed than he is. He searches for the right stuffing to fill himself up and makes a mess along the way. Grizzly, Dinosaur and Kangaroo wonder if they can help their friend find the stuff he is looking for.

This final book in my Toys series is a tale about friendship and personal journeys. The inspiration for *Bunny Finds the Right Stuff* is drawn from my journey of seeking God and fulfilment in life after I came down with Spasmodic Dysphonia, a rare voice disorder. I have since come to realise that the knowledge that God loves me and meaningful relationships are the right stuff for me.

My first book, *Prince Bear & Pauper Bear*, was my “coming out” story where I shared about my struggles with this rare voice disorder through Pauper Bear, a teddy bear without a mouth. *The Tale of Rusty Horse*, my second book, was my “struggle” book, where like Rusty Horse, I came to terms with my station in life. *Just Teddy*, my third book, is my “revelation” book, where I came to realise that I am “fearfully and wonderfully made” (Psalms 139:14).

II TARGET AUDIENCE

The picture book is written for children from four years old and up and also for adults. It is about love, meaningful friendships and having space to grow in our personal journeys.

III. AUTHOR BIOGRAPHY

I am a providential author who wrote and published my debut picture book as a winner of Singapore's First Time Writers and Illustrators Publishing Initiative in end 2007 (organised by the Media Development Authority and the National Book Development Council of Singapore).

My books *Prince Bear & Pauper Bear* and *Just Teddy* have since been honoured amongst the year's best books by the Independent Publisher's Book Awards for 2008 and 2009 (“IPPY Awards”). The IPPY Awards is the world's largest book awards competition. I'm the first person in Southeast Asia to have won the award for children's books since the inception of the Awards 13 years ago and recently became the first in Asia to win 2 IPPY awards. *Prince Bear & Pauper Bear* and *The Tale of Rusty Horse* have also been converted into cartoon by MDA and acclaimed animation studio Peach Blossom and were screened on Okto TV in early 2009.
